Tips For Teachers

Welcome to the new season everyone, my name is David Nolen. I can't wait to do the work & the projects that the Alaska Junior Theater Education Desk is called to do. Do it well. Make it easy for the right people to find us. And, when they get here, treat them like family. Lather, Rinse, Repeat.

Registration deadline was September 11th. **This DOES NOT mean you cannot register after that date.** It is simply the date when I will gather the registrations I have received and start to designate specific dates and times for those classes.

Many of our shows are selling very fast, so if you are interested in seeing an AJT show this season and have not signed up yet, I strongly urge you do so as soon as possible.

When you do register for a show, remember, you must have a principal's signature, and I encourage you to pay a deposit. Those who pay a deposit will get priority seating and a free ticket.

Be very specific about the dates and times you can and cannot attend when you are filling out your registration form. It will help so much when I build the seating schedule!

SOME HELPFUL TIPS AND THINGS TO REMEMBER WHEN REGISTERING:

- Try to register with other teachers in your school to help ensure a ride to the theater (if you are within ASD limits and not a walking school). **Busing is not a guarantee!** You must fulfill the seat requirements found on our Website. Make a note of your numbers and those of the teachers scheduled to go with you. **If the total number is over or under the busing limit, be prepared to have parents drive or coordinate a ride to the theater.**
- The days and times you request are not guaranteed, so never assume they are when you are scheduling, even if the show is not sold out.
- **READ ALL CONFIRMATIONS CAREFULLY!**
- If you send a registration form and do not receive an email confirmation, that means I did not receive the form.
- All shows will be scheduled at least five weeks before the show date. If you have not received your scheduled date and time by then, promptly contact me.
- Read the instructions and steps about registration on our website, where you will find a full rundown of the process, from registration to how to get to the theater. Knowing the process helps clear up most confusion.


