

BUS CAPACITY

Bus transportation is provided within the ASD boundaries for schools that fulfill the busing qualifications for teachers attending the same performance. If you want to ensure that you receive a bus, look at the qualifications and meet those required numbers.

AJT will only provide busing when a minimum of 75% of busing capacity limits are reached. This means that if you have 85 K - 2nd graders from your school attending, only one bus will be provided. In order to qualify for two buses, the number of paid seats would need to be between 124 - 164. If you have less than the minimum required for a bus, we will research the availability of sharing a bus with another school in your area. Bus sharing occurs when there is overflow from one bus or to fill a bus so that your class can attend. We try to review this periodically prior to the show and will email you to see if you have another class that might join you to fill the bus (when space in the show is available). Sharing a bus with another school is not always a guarantee. Due to recent policy changes bus sharing is **ONLY** available for AM shows. **It is not something you should rely on.**

Busing capacity **Minimums - Maximums:**

K - 2nd Grades 62 - 82 seats

3rd - 5th Grades 51 - 68 seats

6th - 12th Grades 45 - 56 seats

Wheelchair bus 39 - 52 seats

Example Bus Scenarios

Example 1: Mrs. Jones registers to see Black Violin and has 30 students in her 1st Grade class. At the time of registration, she notes that she will be attending with Mr. Johnson. When payment deadline arrives, it is discovered that Mr. Johnson never registered and decided not to attend. Busing would only be provided if we had another school to share a bus, or if Mrs. Jones can get another teacher of at least 32 to share a bus with her.

Example 2: Four teachers from elementary school A register to see Red Riding Hood and their total number of seats for their 5th grade classes are 132. They would receive two buses.

Example 3: Five teachers from elementary school B register to see Going on a Bear Hunt and their total number of seats for their 3rd grade classes are 160. Per busing capacity, two buses will be provided with an 'overflow' of 24 seats. If these students do not fit on the buses provided, they would need to ride with chaperones. If chaperones drive themselves, this will help the students fit on the bus. If requested, we will research to see if sharing is an option (depends on availability).
